
For Parents and Visitors


Reminder: All school doors, except the main (South) entrance, are locked.

- A runny nose or just a little cough but no other symptoms.
- Sore throat but no other symptoms.
- No fever in the past 24 hours without fever-reducing medicine
- No vomiting or diarrhea for 24 hours.



KEEP AT HOME

- Fever higher than 100.4 degrees F (38 degrees C).
- Sore throat, with other symptoms such as a persistent cough.
- Vomiting or diarrhea in the past 24 hours.
- Eyes are pink and crusty.
- Has been exposed to an illness where isolation is recommended.



A Note From Mrs. Belland

Happy New Year! I hope you all have had a wonderful break. Here are some things I have been working on and talking about:

- **1.Grade 6:** We have finished off our **Hopeful Minds** lessons for the year. In health classes this month, we will be talking about **Healthy Friendships**.
- 2. **Grade 7:** In health classes we have been learning about **Decision Making** and will be talking about **Emotions**, and how they can either energize us or deplete our energy.
- 3. **Grade 8:** I am just starting our **Mindful Schools** program in SST classes with the Grade 8 classes. Mindfulness in this program is defined as "paying attention on purpose". We start each lesson with a scripture and try various relaxation activities, noticing things such as what we are hearing or what is going on inside our bodies. In health classes, we have also been talking about **Refusal Skills** and health concerns related to **Vaping.**
- 4. **Grade 9:** In January the Grade 9's will be learning about the **Heartmath** program in SST. This program teaches about regulating our emotions. We talk about the different domains of health, how emotions can renew or drain our energy, and a few techniques to shift into a calmer more regulated state. In health classes we have been talking about **Alcohol and Addiction** and health concerns around **Vaping.**
- 5. **Kindness:** With Pink Shirt Day coming up in February, we will be putting some focus on **Kindness** in **all of our classes**. We will be partnering with St Paul FCSS to do activities encouraging Kindness.
